Notice Regarding On-Site and Off-Site Parking – Line Road Facility
Reminder: No Grills, No Dogs, No Alcohol, No Baseball

COACHES: YOUR ADVANCE ATTENTION TO DETAIL ON THIS IS CRITICAL. YOU NEED TO COMMUNICATE EFFECTIVELY WITH YOUR PARENTS/FANS TO ENSURE TRAFFIC SAFETY, PROPER TRAFFIC FLOW AND ENHANCE THE TOURNAMENT EXPERIENCE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS! EACH COACH OR TEAM CONTACT IS RESPONSIBLE TO MAKE SURE PARENTS/COACHES/FANS HAVE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS IN ADVANCE.¹

- *Due to parking constraints at the Line Road Facility attributable to a development project, some teams will play one or two games at West Chester East High School, which is approximately 3 miles away. Please confirm your schedule on the tournament website so your team and entourage arrive at the right field.*
- *Site Layout Maps for each site are on the website, distribute them and ask your team/parents/fans to print and review them. Fields #1-8 are at Line Road; Fields #9-11 are at WC East.*
- *PLAN AHEAD AND CARPOOL to optimize use of the facilities and your tournament experience! Think strategically, space at the Line Road Facility is limited. Consolidate coolers/tents/kids/equipment in vehicles with Line Road Facility Parking Passes. NOTE: it's a 1/3 mile walk from off-site parking this year.*
- *Willistown Police will be stationed at the Line Road Facility and will be patrolling Bryn Mawr Rehab Hospital grounds; they may ticket or tow vehicles, at their discretion, to enforce compliance with these protocols.*

LINE ROAD LOT PARKING PROTOCOLS

1. **LINE ROAD LOT (MAIN TOURNAMENT SITE):** There are two tournament parking areas serving the Line Road Facility during the event (please see Site Layout on the web site):
 - **RESERVED PARKING/PARKING PASSES ONLY** - GCVSA Line Road Lot (137 Line Road, Malvern, PA 19355): Each head coach has been given 8 parking passes. Coaches/contacts are responsible to allocate the passes strategically (i.e. to the team vehicles carrying team tents/coolers, etc.). **ONLY VEHICLES WITH THESE PASSES WILL BE PERMITTED TO PARK IN THE LINE ROAD LOT.** Distribute/use them strategically (i.e., to the vehicles carrying coolers/tents/kids/equipment). Encourage your parents to carpool and consolidate, tell them not to bring heavy items if they don't have a parking pass; it's a 1/3 mile walk from off site parking this year.
 - **LOTS A AND B/BRYN MAWR REHAB GRASS FIELDS** (414 Paoli Pike, Malvern, PA 19355): All vehicles that do not have Line Road Lot Parking Passes must park in Lots A and B. Avoid packing/carrying coolers/tents, it's a 1/3 mile walk to the fields). Travel light, there are food and beverages vendors on site.
2. **LINE ROAD LOT PARKING –GENERALLY:**
 - **ONLY** vehicles with Line Road Lot Parking Passes on display will be permitted access to the Line Road Facility. **PLEASE - NO DROP OFFS!**

¹ *Tournament Parking Protocols have been developed in consultation with 1) Greater Chester Valley Soccer Association, owner of the GCVSA Line Road Field Complex, and 2) Willistown Township Police Department. They are intended to address site constraints, promote the flow of traffic, ensure safety and enhance the Tournament experience for all participants.*

- **DISPLAY PASSES ON REAR VIEW MIRROR: Line Road Lot Parking Passes must be displayed on the rear view mirror of your vehicle (face out) as you approach the facility on Line Road and at all times while your vehicle is parked on site. Line Road Parking Passes feature team names and coaches' cell numbers to facilitate communication and enforcement of Parking Protocols.**
- **HANDICAP PARKING** - Vehicles with handicap parking stickers will be permitted access to the Line Road Lot; handicap stickers must be on display at all times.
- Each coach or team contact is responsible to distribute each team's 8 Line Road Lot Parking Passes to **KEY TEAM PARENTS/DRIVERS** in advance of the event and to coordinate transport of team tents/coolers/kids/equipment. Each coach or team contact is expected to communicate with team parents/drivers and encourage carpooling as much as possible using Line Road Lot Parking Passes.
- **GET IT RIGHT** - If you don't have a Line Road Parking Pass, do not drive to the mouth of the Line Road Facility, you will be asked to continue on and will have to circle back in traffic to Lots A and B and you will be delayed.

3. **LOTS A AND B/BRYN MAWR REHAB HOSPITAL:**

- Go directly to Lots A or B at BMRH if you don't have a Line Road Lot Parking Pass. These grass lots are on either side of the BMRH entrance. Do not block the BMRH entrance, queue on the grass if possible to permit BMRH patients, visitors and staff to pass unimpeded. No event parking or drop offs are permitted beyond Lots A or B at BMRH's express request. Do not interfere with hospital operations by parking in unauthorized places.
 - BMRH and Toll Brothers have supported the Liberty Lacrosse Shootout for years. It is incumbent on all our guests to respect BMRH and Toll Brothers property and their wishes regarding parking. Please be courteous with respect to BMRH patients, visitors and staff members.
 - The walk from Lots A and B to the playing fields along the BMRH driveway and through the "Scenic Cut-Through" is about 1/3 of a mile, potentially a laborious hike over uneven ground with coolers, etc. **Please coordinate with others to load heavy items in the vehicles with Line Road Lot Parking Passes.**
4. **Be Courteous.** While we understand everyone wants their room, parking space is at a premium. We would ask everyone to be courteous and park immediately adjacent to the next car, so we optimize the use of the parking slots that are available.
 5. **Don't Restrict Field Access.** Cones or other markers/barriers will be set up to ensure the flow of pedestrian traffic, cart traffic and emergency access to the fields and to protect "choke points." Do not remove cones or park in spaces that are not *obvious* parking spots, even if only temporarily (parking spots are indicated by cement stoppers). When in doubt, don't! **Vehicles that park in these restricted places will immediately be ticketed or towed. They will also jeopardize their team's participation in the Tournament. Please understand, this is largely a safety issue.**
 6. **No Parking along Line Road.** Parking along Line Road is strictly prohibited and cars parked on the road may be towed by the Willistown Police Department or by private contractors.
