Notice regarding On-site and off-site parking

Tournament Parking Protocols have been developed in consultation with 1) Greater Chester Valley Soccer Association, owner of the GCVSA Line Road Field Complex, and 2) Willistown Township Police Department. They are intended to address site constraints, promote the flow of traffic, ensure safety and enhance the Tournament experience for all participants. Please note:

- *Willistown Police will be stationed at the Line Road Complex and will ticket or tow vehicles, at their discretion, to enforce compliance with these protocols.*
- *Each coach or team contact is responsible to make sure parents/coaches/fans have read these instructions in advance.*
- *PLAN AHEAD AND CARPOOL* to optimize use of the facilities and your tournament experience!

PARKING PROTOCOLS

1. There are two tournament parking areas, the entrance to each is on Line Road (please see Site Layout on the web site):
 - GCVSA Line Road Lot (on-site/RESERVED ONLY; consolidate coolers/tents in vehicles with Line Road Lot Parking Passes)
 - O'Neill Lot (off-site/\$5 per car; this is a grass field with uneven terrain, avoid carrying coolers/tents, *wear appropriate footwear*, exit on Paoli Pike via Bryn Mawr Rehab)
2. RESERVED GCVSA Line Road Lot Parking - PASSES. Depending on the # of teams registered for each day, five (5) to seven (7) Line Road Lot Parking Passes will be made available to each team coach/contact. Coaches/contacts are responsible to allocate the passes strategically (i.e. to the team vehicles carrying team tents/coolers, etc.). **ONLY VEHICLES WITH THESE PASSES WILL BE PERMITTED TO PARK IN THE LINE ROAD LOT.**
3. Line Road Lot Parking –GENERALLY:
 - ONLY vehicles with Line Road Lot Parking Passes on display will be permitted access to the GCVSA Line Road Field Complex. You will be directed into the O'Neill Lot by Willistown Police and/or Tournament Parking Marshalls if you fail to display your Line Road Lot Parking Pass.
 - **Line Road Lot Parking Passes must be displayed on the rear view mirror of your vehicle as you approach the facility on Line Road and at all times while your vehicle is parked on site.**
 - **Line Road Parking Passes feature team names and coaches' cell numbers to facilitate communication and enforcement of Parking Protocols.**
 - Vehicles parked on site that fail to display the Line Road Lot Parking Pass on their rear view mirrors may be ticketed or towed by the Willistown Police.
 - Line Road Lot Parking Passes will be collected from vehicles when they leave the site.
 - Vehicles with handicap parking stickers will be permitted access to the Line Road Lot at no cost; handicap stickers must be on display at all times

- We will forward the Line Road Lot Parking Passes approximately 5 to 7 days before the event (our goal is to mail them out no later than the Sunday before the event).
 - Each coach or team contact is responsible to distribute Line Road Lot Parking Passes to KEY TEAM PARENTS/DRIVERS in advance of the event and to coordinate transport of team tents/coolers.
 - **Parking at the GCVSA Line Road Complex is limited. If your team plans to bring coolers/tents, please plan accordingly. Consolidate heavy items in vehicles with Line Road Parking Passes to avoid transporting them over tough O'Neill Lot terrain.**
 - Each coach or team contact is expected to communicate with team parents/drivers and encourage carpooling as much as possible using Line Road Lot Parking Passes.
4. O'Neill Lot Parking – EXACT CHANGE: Vehicles without Line Road Lot Parking Passes will be directed into the O'Neill Lot and charged \$5 to park. *PLEASE HAVE THE \$5 READY (EXACT CHANGE) WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE EVENT so we can keep the flow of traffic moving.* The walk from the O'Neill Lot to the playing fields through the “Scenic Cut-Through” can be several hundred yards, potentially a laborious hike over uneven ground with coolers, etc. **Please coordinate with others to load heavy items in the vehicles with Line Road Lot Parking Passes.**
 5. Be Courteous. Parking space is at a premium. We would ask anyone who parks in the GCVSA Line Road Lot to be courteous and park immediately adjacent to the next car, so we optimize the use of the parking slots that are available.
 6. Don't Restrict Field Access. Cones or other markers/barriers will be set up to ensure the flow of pedestrian traffic, cart traffic and emergency access to the fields and to protect “choke points.” Generally speaking, do not remove cones or park in spaces that are not *obvious* parking spots (parking spots are indicated by cement stoppers). When in doubt, don't!
 - **Vehicles that park in these restricted places will immediately be ticketed or towed at the direction of the Willistown Police.**
 7. No Parking along Line Road or at BMRH. Parking along Line Road and at Bryn Mawr Rehabilitation Hospital is strictly prohibited and cars parked in either location may be towed by the Willistown Police Department or by private contractors. BMRH has been kind enough to let the Tournament use its driveway to exit the O'Neill Lot and access Paoli Pike. Please be courteous with respect to BMRH patients, visitors and staff members.
